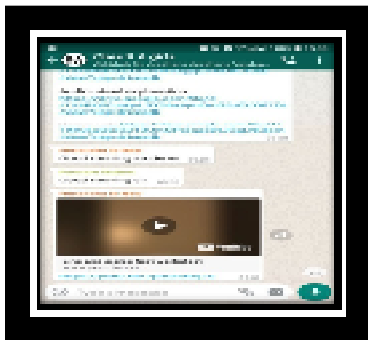
## YEARLY REPORT

Students of the school had shown their love and respect to their mother by making wonderful cards using their creativity and expressed their feelings to their beloved mother.



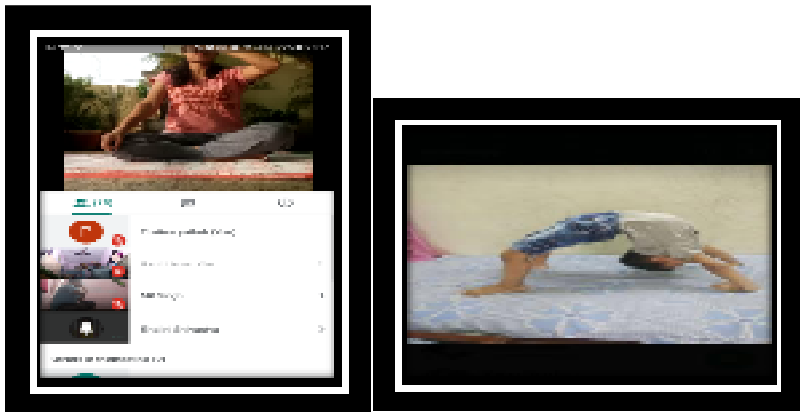
## "INTERNATIONAL YOGA DAY"

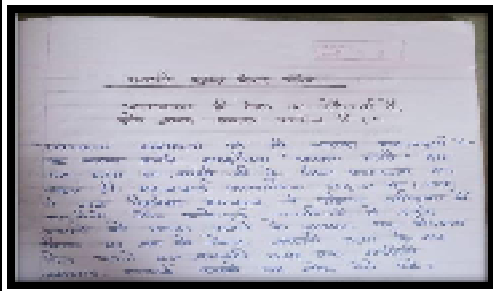


## ONLINE PAINTING AND ESSAY COMPETITION

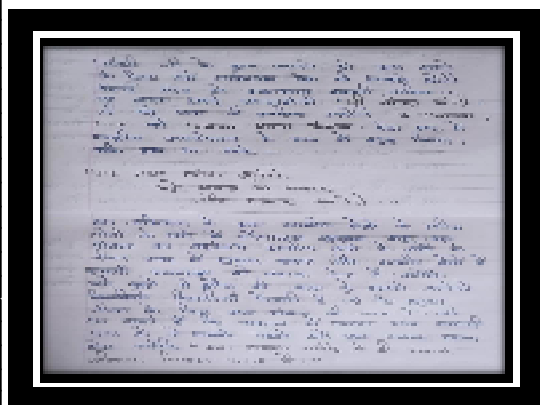


## **"ONLINE ESSAY COMPETITION"**

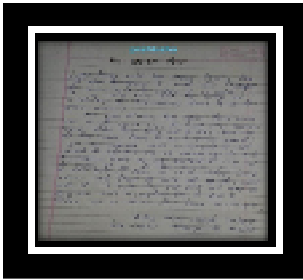


## LITERACY DAY CELEBRATION

**10<sup>th</sup> SEPTEMBER TO 16<sup>th</sup> SEPTEMBER**

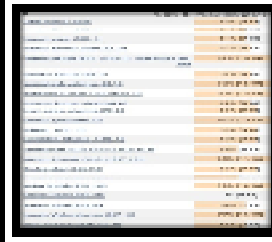
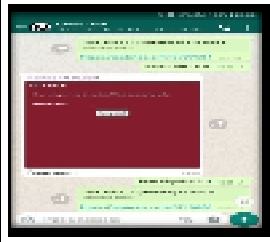

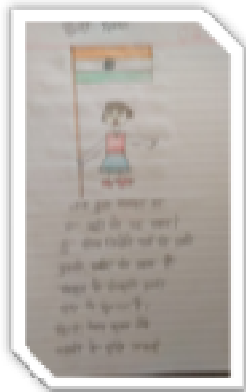
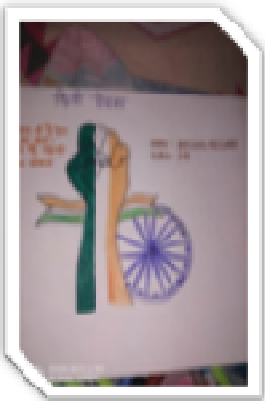
## HINDI DIWAS CELEBRATION

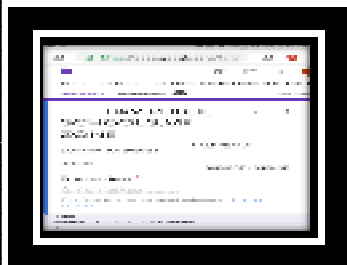


## **ONLINE HALF YEARLY EXAM**

taken by everyone to fight against Corona and in return a certificate was issued to everyone whosoever had filled the form and taken the pledge.



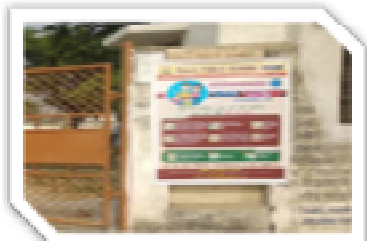
### **ORGANISATION OF CAMPAIGN**

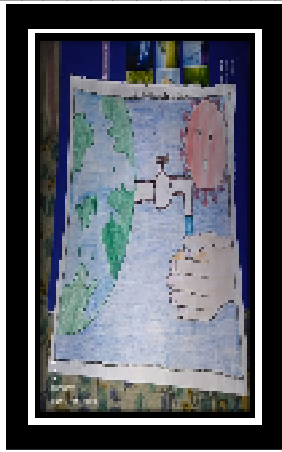


## COMPETITION ON COVID – 19

**29<sup>th</sup> OCTOBER TO 31<sup>st</sup> OCTOBER**

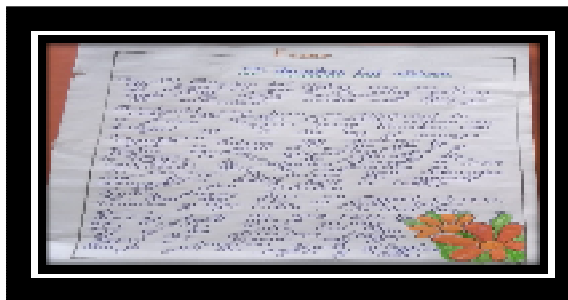
**Capacity Building Programme for

Diwali is the festival of lights which is celebrated in various regions across India. To make the students, understand the importance of Diwali, DAV KV had organized some activities for the

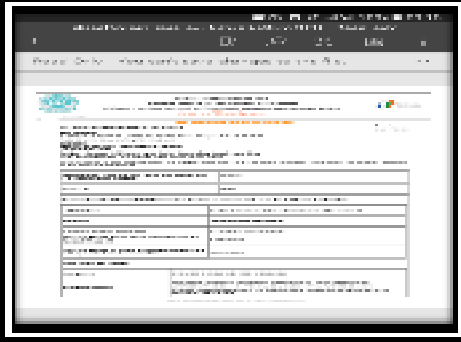

**18<sup>th</sup> DECEMBER TO 24<sup>th</sup> DECEMBER**

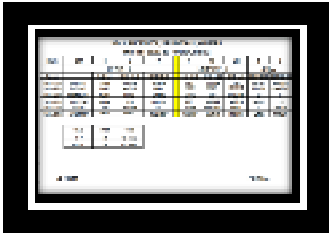
